## Novavax' COVID-19 Vaccine Nuvaxovid™ Arrives in Singapore

Deliveries of Novavax' COVID-19 vaccine continue around the world and the first doses arrived in Singapore this week. The Singapore Health Sciences Authority (HSA) previously granted <u>interim authorization</u> for Nuvaxovid<sup>TM</sup> (NVX-CoV2373) COVID-19 Vaccine (recombinant, adjuvanted) for active immunization to prevent COVID-19 caused by SARS-CoV-2 in individuals 18 years of age and older. Nuvaxovid was the first protein-based vaccine authorized for use in Singapore.
