Novavax Statement on Arrival of its COVID-19 Vaccine in Canada

March 31, 2022

Deliveries of Novavax' COVID-19 vaccine continue around the world, with doses arriving in Canada on March 29. Health Canada granted authorization for NuvaxovidTM COVID-19 Vaccine (Recombinant protein, Adjuvanted) for active immunization to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) caused by the severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) in individuals 18 years of age and older last month.

Release procedures are underway, as required with all vaccines, and it is anticipated that the vaccine will be available to Canadians in the coming weeks.
